



 health insurance enrollment, and more. Our knowledgeable staff ensures
 access to fundamental resources for stability.
- Home Visiting Programs and Child Developmental Screenings: Ensuring every child receives the support they need from the start.
- Free Tax Preparation Services: Putting more money back into the pockets of hard-working families.
- Youth Employment Services: Offering free assistance and paid work experience for teens and young adults facing challenges.
- Housing Stability Services: Including eviction prevention, financial
 assistance for move-in costs, enrollment in utility assistance programs, and
 support for homeless individuals and families.
